On a trailing 4 quarter basis, Q2 saw a record 40 percent adoption of AHV, and 21 percent of deals included Essentials and Enterprise product offerings beyond the Core. We also saw growing momentum toward a recurring revenue model, delivering 57 percent of billings from subscriptions this quarter.



% OF DEALS THAT HAVE **AHV ADOPTION AS %** ONE OR MORE PRODUCTS OF NX NODES SOLD




