In addition, each share of Class B common stock will convert automatically into one share of Class A common stock upon (i) the date specified by affirmative vote or written consent of the holders of at least 67% of the outstanding shares of Class B common stock, (ii) any transfer, whether or not for value, subject to certain limited exceptions, (iii) the death of a natural person (including shares held by his or her permitted estate planning entities holding Class B common stock), or (iv) October 5, 2033.
